### **OUR APPROACH TO CARE**

At Home at Peace, we provide a carefully structured, fully managed domiciliary care service designed to support individuals and families with dignity, consistency and peace of mind.

We believe that high quality care should be transparent, professionally led and centred around the individual. Our fees reflect not only the time spent delivering care, but also the robust systems, safeguarding processes and experienced oversight that ensure every service is safe, reliable and responsive.

As a regulated provider, we take full responsibility for the quality, continuity and accountability of care delivered in the home.

### **AREAS WE SERVE**

We provide domiciliary care across North London, with a strong focus on:

Our localised service model allows us to maintain close oversight, respond promptly to changes in need, and provide continuity of carers for each individual we support.

### **STANDARD DAYTIME HOME CARE**

8 am to 8 pm  
£28 per hour

Our daytime care service is designed to support individuals in maintaining independence, comfort and wellbeing within their own home.

This service includes:

Personal care delivered with dignity and respect  
Medication prompting or administration where assessed  
Meal preparation and nutritional support  
Light domestic tasks related to wellbeing  
Companionship and emotional support  
Daily care records and clear communication with families  
Regular care plan reviews  
Ongoing oversight from our Registered Manager

We operate a minimum visit duration of one hour to ensure that care is delivered safely, without rush, and with full attention to the individual.

### **NIGHT CARE SERVICE**

8 pm to 8 am

From £150 per night

Night care provides reassurance, safety and responsive support throughout the evening and overnight period.

This service includes:

- A trained and vetted care professional present in the home
- Monitoring of wellbeing and safety throughout the night
- Support with toileting, repositioning or medication where required
- Calm reassurance for individuals experiencing anxiety or confusion
- Access to on-call management support if needed
- Full accountability from a regulated care provider

Overnight care may be delivered as either a sleeping night or a waking night service, depending on the assessed needs of the individual. Final arrangements are confirmed following assessment to ensure care is both appropriate and safe.

### **WEEKEND CARE**

£30 per hour

We provide consistent weekend support to ensure continuity of care for individuals and families who require additional assistance outside of standard weekday hours.

Weekend care is delivered to the same high standard, with no reduction in oversight or quality.

### **LIVE-IN CARE**

From £1,900 per week

Live-in care provides a comprehensive, continuous support option for individuals who require ongoing assistance within their home.

This service includes:

- A dedicated live-in care professional
- Daily support with personal care, routines and wellbeing
- Meal preparation and household support
- Companionship and emotional reassurance
- Structured care planning and regular reviews
- Ongoing supervision and support from our management team

Live-in care allows individuals to remain in familiar surroundings while receiving consistent and attentive support tailored to their needs.

## **24-HOUR CARE**

£271 per day

For individuals requiring continuous care across a full 24-hour period, we provide structured support that ensures safety, consistency and responsiveness throughout the day and night.

This service is carefully managed to ensure appropriate staffing, safe working practices and continuity of care.

## **CHILDREN'S DAILY SUPPORT**

7 am to 7 pm

£23 per hour

As part of our transgenerational model of care, we support children alongside adults and older individuals.

Our service is designed to provide safe, responsive and compassionate care that reflects the individual needs of each child and their family.

## **CARE ASSESSMENTS**

We offer a structured initial consultation to understand your needs, discuss your preferences and ensure that Home at Peace is the right fit for you or your loved one.

A one-off consultation fee of £28.00 applies.

This consultation includes:

- A personalised discussion of care needs
- Guidance on suitable support options
- An introduction to our approach and service model

Should you go on to use our services, your first hour of care will be provided at no cost.

## **TRAVEL**

Travel within our North London coverage area is included within our hourly rates.
