### **Notes:**

The above charges are for one carer.

Two weeks charge to be paid prior to the start of the service.

**Minimum Charge:** A minimum charge of 30 minutes applies

**Cancellation of calls** requires a minimum of 48 hours' notice, or the full fee will be charged. A half fee retainer will be charged for any cancellations.

Travel & Mileage expenses to be agreed prior to start of care except emergency call out.

All the above charges will be mutually agreed by both parties.

Charges based upon time periods will be rounded up to the nearest 15 minutes

A waking night is when a service user requires prolonged and/or frequent support during the night and the carer is awake and working. A waking night shift is generally a 10-hours shift from start to finish at times agreed with you.

A Sleep-in is where a carer sleeps at a client's house. This provides the service user with peace of mind should the service user requires support in the night. However, please note that the carer is entitled in the first instance to sleep through the night, and will provide support where required. Please note you must

**provide suitable accommodation for the carer to sleep including a bed. A Sleep-in shift is generally a 10-hour shift from start to finish at times mutually agreed with you. If during the Sleep-in shift the carer is disturbed 2 or more times, the Sleeping-in shift will automatically become a Waking Night and will be charged accordingly.**

**Additional charge will be levied in consultation with the service user for:**

- 1. Liaising with Allied Professionals eg District Nurse, GP, Occupational therapist, Pharmacist should this fall outside contracted time.**
- 2. Managing medications – stock control, ordering, and collection.**
