

Cambridge House fee information

The weekly care home fee is the amount charged each week for a person to live at Cambridge House residential home and receive day-to-day support. It covers **accommodation, meals, personal care and basic support**, though exact inclusions vary by individual persons needs and agreement

How the fee is structured for people with complex needs at Cambridge House

- **Two-part weekly fee** — the total weekly charge is split into **two separate components**:
 1. **Direct individual support fee** — set from the care needs assessment and reflects the number of **1:1 or 2:1 care hours** required to meet the person's identified complex communication, health and behavioural needs. This covers the extra staff time and specialist support needed to keep the person safe and engaged.
 2. **Shared indirect support fee** — covers **shared, indirect care tasks** that the person cannot reasonably participate in (for example laundry, meal preparation, communal activities set-up, and other household tasks). This component funds staff time and resources used
